LERT teams are trained to work through local churches to serve their communities.

The basic LERT training is a four-hour introduction to disaster response.

Advanced LERT trainings include, but are not limited to:

- Chainsaw use and safety
- Debris removal
- Mucking out flooded buildings
- Salvage and restoration
- Tarp and patch
- Helping children to cope after a disaster
- Emotional and spiritual care

Lutheran Church Charities (LCC) is blessed to have more than 50 LERT teams who help people regardless of their ethnic background, social standing or religious affiliation. For LERT volunteers, disaster response is an essential relief and outreach ministry.
